
Bring your vise and equipment to club meetings

Ouachita River Trip

June 24th the club will embark on a escorted trip down the Ouachita River. Scott Letcher along with his partner Lester will guide us down a stretch of river with excellent smallmouth bass fishing. If you need a kayak, Scott Letcher can rent you one.



You must be a club member to go on this trip and sign the insurance form. The cost is nonrefundable \$25. If the date is changed and you cannot attend you forfeit the \$25. The only circumstance that refunds will be made is if the trip is completely cancelled. Sign up at a club meeting. The exact stretch of river will be determined a few days before the trip.
