

This is the clubs annual banquet. The funds raised allow the club to book interesting speakers, partially pay for expenses for club outings, pays dues , insurance, and administrative fees to FFI.

How the Banquet works: Club members are asked to bring an item (or multiple items) to Shane's at approximately 5 pm on Tuesday October 10th. We will begin setting up the bucket draws.
